

SDSG Welcomes Wednesday, March 28, 7 PM

Hollywood Records A&R

SDSG presents a compelling evening for Songwriters and Artists with special guests **Jon Lind**, V.P. A&R, *Hollywood Records*, *Hit Songwriter and Producer* and **Peter Galloway**, *Internationally known Artist, Writer and Producer*. These two career songwriting pros representing different creative directions join us in San Diego the last Wednesday in March.

For over 25 years, Jon Lind has been writing pop mega-hits like "Boogie Wonderland" (Earth, Wind & Fire), "Crazy For You" (Madonna), Vanessa Williams' career songs "Save The Best For Last" and "The Sweetest Days", plus many others. Now Hollywood Records Vice president of A&R, Jon co-wrote and co-produced English group BBMak's soon to be platinum project, with his song "The Ghost Of You And Me", their new single being released this month.

Peter Galloway, a native of New York, formed the Fifth Avenue Band with friend Jon Lind in the 1970's. An acclaimed folk/alternative and acoustic-pop singer, writer and guitarist, Peter has done eleven albums of his material and is responsible for producing almost fifty albums and special projects, including the Grammy nominated "Bleeker Street: Greenwich Village in The 60's" and "Time and Love: The Music of Laura Nyro", a special tribute album. He is currently developing projects for film and record.

Jon and Peter will inform, educate, share with, inspire and even entertain us on March 28th, as part of their desire to give back to the music community. They don't wish to extensively critique or criticize our tapes and CDs, but will listen to one submission by SDSG member artists and writers. The song pitch will be the second part of this great evening. **There is a strict limit of one song only per each current member artist, writer or team. Please keep submissions appropriate to our guests' needs, as noted below.**

Jon is listening for ballads and up tempo hit material for three acts at Hollywood Records: 19 year old **Nydia** - strong intelligent, lyric-driven songs for the Latin artist in the direction of Selena and Christina Aguilera; **Jennifer Paige** - R&B flavored pop artist who scored with the hit "Crush;" and **Nobody's Angels** - youthful girl-group with young lyrics and a pop/urban edge. Less mature and involving lyrics than Nydia. **Of course, our A&R guest also has an interest in finding super, "ready to sign" artists, groups, or bands.** Peter will be listening for material suitable for his own projects. Styles like country, jazz, hip-hop and metal are probably not appropriate for these guests.

Registration opens at 6:15 p.m. Tape submission fees are \$10. Non-member admission is \$20. Remember, the pitch will be open to members only, but you can join SDSG at the door, \$45 annual dues, \$25 for students with valid I.D.

Part of the Universal family of companies, Interscope will be playing a big part in the creation, production and marketing of music for years to come. Tony s last visit with us at SDSG was in March of 1999, and we re excited to have him back on the rescheduled date of Saturday, April 21, 2001.

A man of action, Tony signed **No Doubt** (\$18 million in worldwide sales) and **Bush** to Interscope, and is responsible for **Snoop Dog** and **Brian Setzer**, among others. Interscope is artist -not publishing- oriented. Performers and vocalists are the company s focus. Styles which will be considered are Rock, Pop, Alternative AAA and Metal, R&B, Hip Hop and Country. Tony is not looking for instrumental music.

SDSG at Java Joe's

The name "Java Joe's" usually brings to mind **Jewell, Gregory Page, Steve Poltz**, and a host of local and nationally known performers. So I was very happy to organize and participate in the first ever San Diego Songwriter Guild showcase at Java Joe's. Located at 1956 Bacon Street in Ocean Beach, the club has a great PA, lots of room, and movie posters on the walls. Joe's regular soundman, Wendy, famous for hosting "Wendy's Open Mike" on Monday nights, was on duty with the Air force Reserve, so our sound technician was none other than **Jeff Berkley** of "**Berkley Hart**." Jeff did a great job.

I started off the showcase with my favorite cover song (is this a crime at a songwriter's showcase?) but had the chance to perform several of my originals as the night rolled along. **Sharelle**, new to the Guild and San Diego, performed on both acoustic guitar and keyboard, accompanied by her husband Adam on acoustic guitar. You may recognize Sharelle as the winner in the Pop category of our 2000 SDSG Song Contest. With her rich voice, interesting melodies, and intelligent lyrics, Sharelle went over very well with the crowd, just like she did with the contest judges.

Mark Jackson took the stage next. Accompanied by **Ken Wilcox** on acoustic guitar and **Pat Ambre** on harmonica, Mark played the type of music many people call "Americana." It's a mix of Country and Folk that I personally love. They performed "Desert Wind," a song that goes back to Mark's days with Jackson/Bolland and my favorite of his compositions. Mark has just rejoined the Guild and we are lucky to have him back.

Our last act was "**Myron and the Koniptions**." Guild member **Myron Frame** fronts this four-piece band, performing lead vocals and harmonica. Most of the songs they do are his compositions. With electric guitar, bass, and drums, this band can really bring the house down. They have done so at many of our showcase before and they were hot this night. They received enthusiastic applause from the audience after every song, and Joe, Java Joe's owner, clearly enjoyed this hot blues band.

In all, it was a great night at Java Joe's. We are very grateful to Joe for having us, and to Jeff Berkley for making us sound, well, great! Thanks to those of you who came out to support us. Our next showcase at Java Joe's is On Sunday, April 22nd. Hope you can join us.

" THE PITCH SESSION "

PRODUCERS, PUBLISHERS, A&R REPRESENTATIVES, MANAGERS and ARTISTS may screen for a specific recording project. They use these events to find songs, singers, musicians, etc. Our guests may critique your song and give you valuable feedback on how you could improve upon it if time permits. The guest may "pick-up" your song which means they would like to hear it again for further consideration.

Submission Rules

- One song per Guild Member will be listened to before those of Non-Members.
- On exceptionally busy nights, we reserve the option to limit the number of tapes submitted by an individual to any event. This option applies equally to those members submitting tapes by mail. We ask that writers number their tapes, #1 being your first choice, #2 your second, so that we may play them according to your priorities.
- Due to time limits, we cannot guarantee that your song will be heard in the Pitch Session.

Fees

- For the submission price of \$10 per song (limit 1 to 2 songs per writer, varies with guests), you may enter your song(s) for the Pitch Session. Members may sign up songs in advance.
- You may join The San Diego Songwriters Guild on the night of an event for a \$45 yearly membership fee.
- Non-members are charged a \$20 door fee in addition to tape submission fees. The door fee must be paid by non-members wishing to pitch songs. Some pitch events are open only to SDSG members

How It Works

- Bring neatly typed lyric sheet and CD or cassette cued to the beginning of the song you want heard.
- Tapes will not be accepted for the Pitch Session after the start of the event.
- Be sure to include your name and phone number on both your lyric sheet and your tape or CD because they may get separated.
- The Pitch Session is limited to 70 tunes. Once event is filled, sign up is closed, even if the event has not started. SDSG reserves the right to limit the number of submissions further.
- When you check in your song, sign in all names of writers, song title and phone number, so that others who hear your song can contact you.
- Submissions will be referred to by song title. Writers may or may not remain anonymous during the Pitch session depending on our guest for that event.

Join the San Diego Songwriters Guild. Membership dues are \$45.00 annually. Timely renewals are \$40.00 per year.

On the Value of Follow Up

One of SDSG member Mark Jackson's songs wound up being used in a local play. Mark tells how it came to pass...

It just so happened I met director Annette Spadafore one afternoon in November outside the playhouse here in Chula Vista. She told me she would be directing a play called "Somewhere in Between." I told her I had written a song by that same name several years before and she said she would be interested in checking it out. I sent her the lyrics in which she liked, so I then recorded a rough guitar/vocal track of the song and sent it to her.

I didn't hear from her after that and had pretty much let this one go, but she responded to a mailing list e-mail I sent out a couple of weeks ago. She said that the song was already in the pre-show music and would be listed in the program. My wife and I went to the opening on Friday, March 9, and the play was wonderful!
